Focus of the Team and your Tasks.

Nowadays a vast amount of a car's value creation process takes place in the automotive supplier industry. Besides the quality of purchased parts and components especially their on-time delivery and the fulfilment of capacity demands is crucial for successful manufacturing processes of automakers.

Within BMW's global Purchasing and Supplier Network our team is responsible for the management and assessment of suppliers, focussing on UK-based suppliers. In accordance with BMW's product development process we focus on both the early industrialisation phase as well as the series production phase of cars, in which we have a close link to the organisation's headquarter in Munich. Our team addresses the following key activities:

Industrialisation Phase:

- Supply Chain Design under consideration, assessment and qualification of new suppliers
- Management and supervision of the launch process of new supplier parts and components
- Coordination with process partners especially from purchasing, logistics, quality and assembly

Series Phase:

- Provide support in case of complex changes and issues within the UK-based supply chain network
- Support series with value stream and process optimization activities
- Monitoring and escalation of critical quality and supply related problems

Depending on whether you choose to support the team for industrialisation or series production topics your tasks will be among the ones mentioned below:

- Develop, recommend and monitor corrective and preventive actions for quality based issues in the industrialisation resp. series phase of our vehicle projects
- Managing departmental quality KPIs, including liaison with process partners to deliver accurate results

- Tracking the maturity level of launch and series parts from suppliers
- Analysing and assessing UK's supplier base to identify potential business partners
- Processing and presenting quality and value stream management related data (e.g. timing, tooling)
- Progression of supplier data in support of audit preparation
- Running and participating in regular team and production related meetings
- Improving internal and external communication channels and platforms for our department
- Driving individual projects throughout the placement - this includes the development and optimization of processes and tools in order to improve our daily activities

Qualifications and Experiences.

- Studying an Engineering or a Business related degree
- Excellent IT skills in Microsoft Office (esp. Excel and PowerPoint)
- Excellent language skills in English and German
- Strong analytical, communication and presentation skills
- Ability to work independently as well as in a team
